Grapes 100% Sangiovese grosso, locally known as Brunello

Region Montalcino (Si) locality of Piancornello, Tuscany

Ageing 36 months in Slavonian 20/25 hl oak barrels followed by a minimum of 8 months in the bottle at controlled temperatures

Tasting notes Bright ruby in color with garnet hints, this wine presents a perfume of ripe red fruits, delicately interwoven with sweet spices such as vanilla and chocolate, resting on an ethereal and balsamic background, enhanced by subtle notes of tobacco and officinal herbs. On the palate, it exhibits great intensity, fullness, and roundness, all perfectly balanced by its freshness and solid structure. The tannins are both robust and soft, lending the wine an air of elegance and persistence, while also promising a remarkably long aging potential.

Grapes 100% Sangiovese grosso, locally known as Brunello

Region Montalcino (Si) locality of Piancornello, Tuscany

Ageing 42 /48 months in Slavonian 20/25 hl oak barrels followed by 6/12 months in the bottle

Tasting notes Bright ruby and transparent in color with hints of garnet, this wine offers a fragrant bouquet of fruity notes, elegantly layered with spice and tobacco leaves. With an alcohol content of 15.0% Vol., it reveals a remarkable balance between acidity and softness, seamlessly integrated with an extraordinarily tannic structure. This harmony grants the wine both elegance and strength, making it well-suited for aging.

Grapes 100% Sangiovese grosso, locally known as Brunello

Region Montalcino (Si) locality of Piancornello, Tuscany

Ageing 12 months in wooden barrels, tonneaux or barriques, followed by a minimum of 4 months if barriques at controlled temperatures

Tasting notes Lively, intense, and bright red in color with vibrant reflections, this wine reveals a clear and fresh bouquet, marked by notes of fresh red fruit that harmonize with tertiary aromas, notably dried tobacco. On the palate, it is ample, persistent, and lively, supported by a subtle and refined tannic structure that adds elegance and depth to the overall experience.

Grapes Sangiovese grosso, locally called Brunello, 60%; Merlot 20%; Cabernet Sauvignon 10%; Syrah 10%

Region Montalcino (Si) locality of Piancornello, Tuscany

Ageing 12 months in 500/250 litre oak containers followed by a minimum of four months in the bottle at controlled temperatures

Tasting notes Intense and bright ruby in color, with luminous violet reflections, this wine offers a clear and expressive bouquet, dominated by ripe red fruit notes, particularly blackberry and blackcurrant, enriched by distinct sweet spice aromas. On the palate, it is round, warm, and inviting, with balanced acidity, well-integrated tannins, and a fragrant character that enhances its overall appeal.

Grapes Sangiovese grosso 60%, Syrah 30%, Merlot

Region Montalcino (Si) locality of Piancornello, Tuscany

Ageing 18 months steel, 4 months in glass minimum

Tasting notes Intense and brilliant ruby red in color, with luminous violet reflections, this wine displays a clean and pronounced bouquet, featuring mature red fruits alongside notes of clove and dark chocolate. On the palate, it is round and warm, supported by balanced acidity and a long, persistent finish that enhances its depth and character.
